# WOMEN'S SOCCER.....2

**Overall Record: 8-7-1**

**Skyline Conference Record: 5-4**

• Sage earned a spot in the upcoming 2009 Skyline Conference Playoffs after earning the No. 5 seed. The seed came by virtue of the team's 7-0 win over Maritime College. Sage finished the 2009 regular-season with an 8-7-1 overall record and a 5-4 record in conference play.

Next up for the Gators is a run for the league's championship crown and an automatic bid to the 2009 NCAA Division III Championship. First, the team must travel to Mt. St. Mary College for a 7 p.m. match-up in the quarterfinals on Nov. 3. In the regular-season meeting of the two teams, the Knights would score a 1-0 win after tallying the lone goal of the match in the 85th minute of the match. The winner advances to Thursday's semifinal contest at top-seeded Farmingdale State College.

• Sophomore forward **Rebecca Marszalek (Adams, MA/Hoosack Valley)** added two more goals to her resume and now has 32 points on 15 goals and two assists. She surpassed her totals from her rookie season (14g, 3 a, 31 pts.) and now has 29 goals, five assists and 63 points. She currently ranks third all-time with her career goals and is fourth on the career point list as well in just 34 games played as a Gator.

• Team tri-captain **Ashley Allain (Stillwater, NY/Stillwater)** leads the team and the league with her 0.71 assists per game average. Allain has four goals, 10 assists and 18 points this fall, which is second best on the 2009 squad and leads the conference in avg.

• Senior tri-captain **Krystal Cozzens (Cohoes, NY/Cohoes)** had a strong finish to her regular-season as she added a goal and an assist on the game-winning goal on Senior Day. Cozzens now has a personal-best six goals with an assist, good enough for 13 points. Overall on her collegiate career, she has 12 goals, three assists and 27 points in 59 games played.

• Junior defender **Amanda Potter (Schenectady, NY/Schalmont)** now has nine points on three goals and three assists, which is fourth highest on the squad.

• Junior **Nicole Killeen (Petersburgh, NY/Berlin)** was a candidate for the 2009 CoSIDA-ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District Team. She has chipped in a goal and an assist thus fall, elevating her career totals to 13 goals, three assists and 29 career points. She sports



a 3.6 gpa as an elementary education and psychology major.

• Rookie **Grace Collett (Watervliet, NY/Watervliet)** added two goals in the win over Maritime, elevating her output to four goals which is the leader amongst the 2009 Sage rookies.

• **Rachel Wampler (Carlisle, PA/Carlisle)** has two goals this fall, while juniors **Sarah Briggs (Cohoes, NY/Cohoes)**, **Laura Tisinger (Gloversville, NY/Gloversville)**, and **Samantha DeFoe (Galway, NY/Galway)**, as well as rookies **Kendell Wilbert (Boonville, NY/Adirondack)**, **Dana Spuck (Fairport, NY/Charles Finney)**, and **Kendell Wilbert (Boonville, NY/Adirondack)** all have one goal a piece.

• Freshman forward **Rebecca Doble (Troy, NY/Lansingburgh)** has racked up five assists this fall.

• Among the regular contributors this fall has also been **Olivia Sullivan (Copenhagen, NY/Copenhagen)**, who has appeared in 14 games thus far.

• Sage's starting goalie this fall has been junior **Brittany McDonald (Schenectady, NY/Schalmont)**. McDonald now has five solo shutouts and one shared shutout this fall. She ranks second in the league with her .858 saves percentage, fourth in saves with 115, and fifth in goals against average (1.23).

# WOMEN'S TENNIS.....3

**Overall Record: 9-4 (Season Complete)**

**Skyline Conference Record: 6-2**

• Sage's women's tennis team closed the year with an 8-1 road win over Massachusetts College of Liberal Arts on November 1. The victory puts Sage at 9-4 this fall, while elevating head coach Cedric Gaddis's career record to 23-19. The Gators also posted their second straight winning season after a 10-5 record a year ago.

• In the match with the Trailblazers, Sage would take all three doubles matches and dropped only one match on the day at third singles.

• Sage's senior **Christina Gray (Clifton Park, NY/Shenendehowa)** did not drop a single game in either her singles or doubles matches and finishes the season riding a seven-match win streak in singles play as well as a seven-match win streak in doubles action.

Gray would lead the team with a 13-2 overall record in singles play, including a 12-0 record in dual action. Overall on her singles career as a Gator, she is 24-3, while owning a 22-4 record in doubles. She will also bring a perfect 17-0 record in Skyline Conference singles action into next season.

• Against the Trailblazers, Sage's junior captain **Kathryn Saulsbery (Colonie, NY/Colonie Central)** would play at second singles and teamed

with Gray at first doubles. In her singles match, Saulsbery was a 6-0, 6-3 victor which puts her at 7-4 in singles on the year. She also went 7-5 in doubles, including a 3-0 record when playing at first doubles. Saulsbery is now 20-17 on her career in singles play, while owning a 22-18 record in doubles play. She owns a combined career

record of 42-35 as a Gator for a .545 career win percentage.

• Sophomore **Briana Bixler (Highland, NY/Highland)** added a record of 9-4 this fall in singles play, while having produced a 4-6 record in

doubles action.

• Junior **Devin Money (Syracuse, NY/Corcoran)** added a 5-1

record this fall in singles play. She also teamed with rookie **Julia DeMarco (Duanesburg, NY/Duanesburg)** for success at doubles. Money went 5-1 overall this fall with a 3-1 record with DeMarco.

• **DeMarco** went 2-0 in singles action and 4-1 in doubles play this season.

• Junior **Ashley Brennan (Loudonville, NY/Colonie Central)** went 2-8 in singles and 4-5 in doubles action this fall.

• Rookie **Megan Holmes (West Camp, NY/Saugerties)** has also contributed for the team to a 4-7 record in singles with a 6-4 record in doubles play.

• Sage's sophomore **Erica Fitzgerald (Queensbury, NY/Queensbury)** did not play against MCLA, but would post an impressive record of 9-5 in singles this fall, while adding an 11-3 record in the lineup at first doubles.

# WOMEN'S VOLLEYBALL.....4

**Overall Record: 11-22**

**Skyline Conference Record: 7-2**

• The Gators faced three regionally ranked opponents last week and would wrap the 2009 season with a spot in the upcoming Skyline Conference Tournament. Sage stands at 11-22 overall and has earned the No. 3 seed in the tournament.

The Gators will host SUNY-Old Westbury on Wednesday, November 4 in the Neff Athletic Center. Action gets underway in the quarterfinals at 7 p.m. The tournament will move to top seeded NYU-Poly on November 7 with the semifinals and championship all wrapping the tournament and awarding the conference's automatic bid to the upcoming NCAA Division III Tournament, a title the Gators are looking to maintain having won the championship in both 2007 and 2008.

• Middle hitter **Nicole Corbett (East Greenbush, NY/Columbia)**, who is a candidate for the 2009 ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District Team, as well as the 2009 AVCA All-America Team, leads the Gators with her 103 blocks and now has 240 kills, good enough for a 2.12 per set average. She had a banner week and earned a spot on the Vassar College All-Tournament Team for her play. She moved into the No. 2 spot on Sage's career blocks list as she racked up 15 blocks last week, putting her at 103 this fall and 364 on her career. She moved ahead of Elizabeth St. Dennis (363, 2004-



06). She also has 870 kills on her career, which ranks her fifth all-time in Gator history. Overall on the year, the junior has added 58 solo blocks and 45 block assists and ranks second in the league with her 0.91 blocks per set average. She has a .281 attacking percentage (3rd best in the league) and has started all 113 sets.

• Sage's senior middle hitter **Kellie Jones (Troy, NY/Troy)** has racked up 228 kills with 331 digs this year. She continues her assault on Sage's career leader board as well. She now has 646 kills and is in sixth place behind Corbett, while adding 1,174 career digs which is now fourth best. She stands in fourth all-time with her 180 career serving aces. She is ranked 10th in the league with her 2.93 digs per set and has

also started all 113 matches this fall.

• Sophomore setter **Kristin Buonincontra (Shelton, CT/Shelton)** leads the team with her 744 setting assists (6.58 per set), which is third highest amongst the league's players. She has added 61 services aces and ranks seventh in the league. She has also racked up 168 digs and 41 kills, while playing in all 113 sets this fall.

• Junior outside hitter **Sarah Peacock (Duanesburg, NY/Duanesburg)**, another of the Gators' 2009 ESPN The Magazine Academic All-District candidates, leads the team with 247 kills, good enough for a 2.19 kills per set average and is ranked 10th in the league. She also has 379 digs and ranks sixth in the league with a 3.35 per set average. In her two seasons with Sage, Peacock now has 801 career digs with 384 career kills.

• Junior **Michelle DeNisco (New Hampton, NY/Goshen)** has 90 kills with 29 serving aces, 58 digs and 40 blocks, including 18 solo blocks.

• Sophomore libero **Kelsey Wilson (Schenectady, NY/Bishop Gibbins)** leads the Gators with 417 digs and a 3.69 digs per set average. She has added 28 serving aces as well. On her young Gator career, she already has 723 digs.

• Junior **Cheryce Harvey (Utica, NY/Thomas R. Proctor)** has played in all 113 sets as well this fall and has 235 digs with 24 blocks, and 46 kills.
